



# NARCOTICS INVESTIGATOR

### DRUG TASK FORCE

The Office of the Attorney General is seeking qualified candidates for a Narcotics Investigator located in the New Hampshire Attorney General's Drug Task Force. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated, and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New Hampshire.

#### ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- Responds to scenes to assist other divisions and agencies on narcotic related offenses.
- Receives and acts on information from citizens on narcotics related activity.
- Conducts controlled purchases, buy-busts and covert operations.
- Recruits and manages confidential informants.
- Conducts surveillance of narcotic traffickers.
- Prepares probable cause affidavits for the arrest of offenders identified during investigations.
- Plans and participates in search and arrest warrant executions.
- Obtains and serves search and arrest warrants, including seizing property.
- Utilizes still and video photography. Records statements and confessions.
- Prepare and present investigative reports to the respective prosecutorial authority.
- Assist the NH Attorney General's Office and the United States Attorney with cases for grand jury and trial preparation.
- Assists other agencies, divisions, sections or personnel as needed or directed.
- Testifies in state, federal, municipal courts concerning investigative work performed.
- Maintains intelligence information on narcotics traffickers, street and prison gang members, and drug trafficking organizations operating in the New Hampshire area.
- Maintains ledger and receipts for all investigation related expenditures.
- Collect and secures evidence, maintaining a chain of custody.
- Works in an undercover capacity when required.
- Potential assignment to a federal narcotics task force as a task force officer.

#### QUALIFICATIONS:

- Certification as a law enforcement officer in New Hampshire, or out-of-state police certification recognized by [New Hampshire Police Standards Training Council](#).
- Three years of experience as a law enforcement officer. Previous investigative experience preferred in lieu of patrol experience.
- Applicants are required to participate in an oral board interview and an extensive background investigation.
