Re: **Notice of Data Breach**

To the Office of the Attorney General:

I am sending this notice pursuant to N.H. Rev. Stat. § 359-C:20 to inform the Office of the Attorney General that my client, Anchor Loans LP ("Anchor"), recently became aware of a data breach. On or about November 7, 2016, a security watch group, MacKeeper, accessed an Anchor database that was hosted on an Internet server. Later that week, Anchor learned of the breach and confirmed it, determining that a development server had been improperly configured and was accepting anonymous connections over the Internet. We identified the following categories of personal information stored in the affected database: name, address, e-mail address, SSN, ACH routing number, bank account number, bank statement data, birthdate, and birthplace. Once the company became aware that its database had been exposed in this way, the company reacted swiftly by reconfiguring the database and securing the data. Anchor also retained a security consulting firm to conduct additional security assessments.

During the investigation, one (1) New Hampshire resident was identified whose personal information was compromised, and they have been notified in compliance with New Hampshire Statutes. I have attached a sample of the notice herewith.
