Re: *Security Breach Notification*

Dear Attorney General Delaney:

I am writing on behalf of Argotec to report a potential security breach. On July 26, 2013, Argotec learned that a safe containing several backup tapes is missing from its offices. Argotec believes that the safe has been missing since July 26, 2013. The backup tapes contain personal information of Argotec's current and former employees. We have been unable to ascertain whether any current or former employee's personal information has been accessed or acquired. As such, notice under New Hampshire law is not required. Nevertheless, there is the potential that the personal information of Argotec employees may have been accessed or acquired by an unauthorized person.

Accordingly, out of an abundance of caution, on August 7, 2013, Argotec notified approximately 3 New Hampshire residents of the breach by sending each a written notice of the incident. We are taking every appropriate step to remedy this situation and to recover the missing safe and backup tapes, including informing the Massachusetts Attorney General's office about this incident. Again, we have been unable to find any evidence to suggest that personal data has actually been compromised or misused as a result of this incident.
