

Re: Disclosure required per NH RSA 359-C:20

Dear Attorney General MacDonald,



On June 10, 2019, CCNH became aware that CCNH employees were targeted by an email phishing attack from a compromised CCNH email account. The likely cause of this attack was an email from a compromised entity. In response to the discovery, CCNH began an immediate investigation to prevent further risk to client information. Based on CCNH's investigation, it was determined that one email account was compromised due to the incident. After reviewing the email account, it was determined that 15 New Hampshire residents and entities had personal information in the email, as defined by NH RSA 359-C:20. At this time, CCNH is unable to determine whether this information has or will be misused.

In response to the incident, CCNH has mailed written notice to the affected individuals and entities on Monday, August 5, 2019. CCNH will offer credit monitoring services to all individuals that are notified. Additionally, CCNH will be providing training to all staff with email accounts and has a phishing awareness program and other appropriate measures to prevent a future incident such as this. CCNH understands the importance of protecting personal information of its clients throughout the state of New Hampshire and will do its best to ensure the security and confidentiality of our clients' information.
