Incident Notification

Dear Attorney General Foster:

We are writing on behalf of our client, CBIZ MHM, LLC ("CBIZ"), to notify you of a security incident involving one (1) New Hampshire resident.

On June 13, 2018, as part of an ongoing forensic investigation, CBIZ discovered that an unauthorized individual had gained access to an employee's email account. Upon discovery, CBIZ immediately reset the employee's password and changed account settings to enhance security. The investigation determined that unauthorized individual(s) had accessed the employee's email account between May 21, 2018 and May 22, 2018. CBIZ undertook a comprehensive review of the emails in the employee's email account and determined that an email or attachment contained certain information about some of its clients, which may have included names, addresses, Social Security numbers, driver's license numbers, and financial account numbers.

CBIZ will mail notification letters via U.S. mail on July 19, 2018, to the New Hampshire resident involved, in accordance with N.H. RSA § 359-C:20, in substantially the same form as the enclosed letter. CBIZ is offering eligible individuals a complimentary, one-year membership in credit monitoring and identity theft protection services from Experian.

To help prevent this type of incident from happening again, CBIZ has taken and is continuing to take significant steps to enhance its existing email security measures and provide additional training to employees on the dangers of phishing emails.

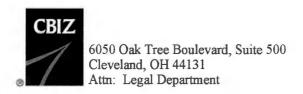

On June 13, 2018, as part of an ongoing forensic investigation, we discovered that an unauthorized individual had gained access to an employee's email account between May 21, 2018 and May 22, 2018. We immediately secured the email account. The investigation determined that the unauthorized individual accessed an email or attachment that contained your name and Variable Data 1.

We have no indication that your personal information has been misused in any way. As a precaution, we have arranged for you to receive a complimentary one-year membership of Experian's® IdentityWorks<sup>SM</sup> Credit 3B. This product helps detect possible misuse of your personal information and provides you with identity protection services focused on immediate identification and resolution of identity theft.
