Certegy Check Services, Inc. ("Certegy"), a service provider to U.S. retail merchants, based in St. Petersburg, Florida, recently provided you with information regarding the misappropriation and sale by a former employee of certain consumer information maintained by Certegy.

As a result of continued investigation, Certegy has determined that additional consumers in your jurisdiction were affected by the misappropriation. Certegy commenced mailing notification to the additional consumers on July 18, 2007, and expects this mailing to be completed by July 31, 2007. Certegy's investigation is continuing and we will provide you with a revised number of affected consumers in your jurisdiction at the conclusion of that investigation.

While Certegy's investigation continues, it has seen no evidence that bank account or credit card information was used for anything other than marketing purposes, and is unaware of any instance of identity theft or fraudulent financial activity caused by this incident. Most importantly, Certegy is doing everything possible to ensure that any inconvenience experienced by consumers is minimized.
