Re: Incident Notification

Dear Attorney General Foster:

I am writing on behalf of our client, CPT Group, Inc. ("CPT"), and three (3) of its Data Providers, to supplement our April 27, 2018 notice to your office.

As explained in our previous notice, on April 3, 2018, CPT notified the parties that had provided the data to CPT ("Data Providers") that was involved in the incident and offered to provide notification to the potentially affected individuals on behalf of those Data Providers, and as well as complimentary credit monitoring services, call center services, and required regulator notifications. CPT requested that the parties respond to its offer by April 13, 2018. On April 27, 2018, CPT sent written notification via U.S. Mail to (10) New Hampshire residents on behalf of the Data Providers that had accepted CPT's offer.

Since the initial notices were sent, three (3) additional Data Providers have requested that CPT provide the offered services on their behalf. CPT agreed to do so, and notified an additional ten (10) new Hampshire residents of the incident in writing in accordance with N.H. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 359-C:20² in substantially the same form as the letter provided to your office on April 27, 2018. CPT has provided all potentially affected individuals with a complimentary one-year membership in credit monitoring and identity theft protection services from Kroll. CPT has also

provided a telephone number for potentially affected individuals to call with any questions they may have.

To date, CPT has provided notice to a total of 20 New Hampshire residents CPT provided notice to the individuals as soon as possible and without undue delay after CPT received affirmative responses from the Data Providers CPT notified of the incident. The Data Providers were notified of the incident within 30 days after the forensic investigation determined that the documents in the affected email account contained personal information of New Hampshire residents (as CPT was not the data owner).
