Dear Attorney General Foster:

In accordance with the provisions of New Hampshire RSA 359-C:20, I(b) we are writing to notify you of a potential unauthorized access of personal information involving one hundred eighty-nine (189) New Hampshire residents.

On April 8, 2015, a former employee of Harbor Homes, Inc. ("Harbor Homes") requested that Harbor Homes send a copy of his Form W-2 for 2014 to the former employee's e-mail address. An employee of Harbor Homes mistakenly attached an electronic file containing the Forms W-2 for 2014 for this former employee, as well as other Harbor Homes' employees, to the e-mail sent to the former employee. The Forms W-2 included personal information of the Harbor Homes' employees, including full names, addresses and Social Security Numbers. The former employee reported noticing the error upon opening the electronic file on April 15, 2015, at which time he closed the file, deleted it from his computer system and notified Harbor Homes. The former employee has confirmed in writing that he did not review, copy, transmit, or disclose any of the personal information of Harbor Homes' employees included in the electronic file. The personal information of one hundred eighty-nine (189) New Hampshire residents was included in this electronic file.

Harbor Homes has decided out of an abundance of caution to provide notice to all one hundred eighty-nine (189) New Hampshire residents as soon as possible. We anticipate that the mailing of notifications to New Hampshire residents shall commence on May 15, 2015. Enclosed herein, please find a sample notification letter that will be sent to the affected New Hampshire residents.
