Dear Attorney General Delaney:

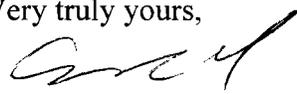
We submit this notification on behalf of our client, Incorporating Services, Ltd. ("ISL"), regarding some of the personal information maintained by ISL in connection with its services.

On April 2, 2012, ISL was notified by its internet hosting vendor that one of ISL's servers was compromised by a malware attack. ISL recently completed a comprehensive investigation of this incident. The investigation revealed that the malicious software allowed an unauthorized party to access data stored on the server. The data included names, addresses, telephone numbers, e-mail addresses and, in some instances, social security numbers and/or bank account information and/or credit card information.

To date, ISL is not aware of any misuse of its clients' personal information or any other fraudulent activity related to this incident. However, as a precautionary measure, ISL is notifying all affected individuals of this incident and offering them one year of free credit monitoring through Experian. There are 4 New Hampshire residents potentially affected by this incident. Notification is being sent to those residents in the forms attached hereto.

ISL considers the privacy of its clients' personal information to be of the utmost importance and is taking the necessary and appropriate steps to help prevent similar incidents in the future. In this regard, ISL has engaged a new internet hosting vendor, replaced the compromised server, and implemented additional security measures for its systems consistent with safeguarding personal information.

The privacy and confidentiality of our clients' personal information is of the utmost importance to Incorporating Services, Ltd. ("ISL"). Regrettably, we write to inform you of an incident related to some of your personal information provided to us in connection with our services.

On April 2, 2012, our internet hosting vendor informed us that one of our servers was compromised by a malware attack. We recently completed an extensive investigation of this incident in order to determine the scope of the attack and the individuals potentially affected.

Our investigation revealed the malicious software allowed an unauthorized party to access data stored on the server. Some of the data pertained to credit card payments made to ISL, which included your name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, credit card number, credit card expiration date, and credit card security code. However, the compromised information did NOT contain your Social Security number.

To date, we are not aware of any misuse of your information or any other fraudulent activity related to this incident. However, we suggest you promptly contact your credit card company to have a new card issued and monitor your credit card statement for any inappropriate activity. Additionally, in an abundance of caution, we are providing you with a free one-year membership in Experian's ProtectMyID™ Elite. This product helps detect possible misuse of your personal information and provides you with identity protection services focused on immediate identification and resolution of identity theft.

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Our investigation revealed the malicious software allowed an unauthorized party to access data stored on the server. In some instances, this data included the Social Security numbers of corporate officers, required to obtain an EIN for newly formed corporate entities. In this regard, your name and Social Security number were contained on the server. However, the compromised data did NOT contain any of your credit card, banking, or other financial account information.

To date, we are not aware of any misuse of your information or any other fraudulent activity related to this incident. However, in an abundance of caution, we are providing you with a free one-year membership in Experian's ProtectMyID™ Elite. This product helps detect possible misuse of your personal information and provides you with identity protection services focused on immediate identification and resolution of identity theft.

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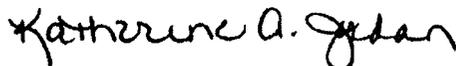
