Re: Data Security Breach

To Whom It May Concern:

I write to disclose a data security breach sustained by Sands Casino Resort Bethlehem that involved the disclosure of personal information regarding approximately 17 residents of New Hampshire. Based on our investigation to date, we believe that we were the victim of a malicious intrusion into our Company's internal systems, and that, as part of the attack, the perpetrators would have had access to files that contained personal information.

The breach was discovered on February 10, 2014, when the company became aware of unauthorized third party access to certain of its electronic systems. At that time, the categories of information believed to have been involved were the names, personal e-mail addresses, social security numbers, and job titles of certain present and former employees of this company. The information in question was made publicly available for a period of time. Following this discovery, we notified all affected individuals and state agencies and entities pursuant to the statutory requirements of each affected state. At that time, we did not believe that New Hampshire residents had been affected.

On February 17, we discovered that certain customers and other individuals, including 17 residents of New Hampshire, had been affected by this incident, and that the perpetrators may have accessed information including their names, social security numbers, driver's license numbers, and/or passport numbers. I enclose a copy of the form of letter that is being used to notify New Hampshire individuals whose personal information we believe may have been accessed or acquired. We expect that the letters will be mailed next week. The incident remains the focus of significant ongoing investigation. We will keep you apprised of any pertinent developments with respect to residents of New Hampshire.

I am contacting you regarding the recent security breach concerning Sands Bethlehem customer information. As you may have read, our Company has been the victim of a malicious and crippling cyber-attack. On Monday, February 10, 2014, the Company became aware of unauthorized third party access to employee information contained in certain of our information technology systems. At this time we do not know the exact date on which the breach first occurred. On February 17, we discovered that this third party had also accessed customer information. During this criminal intrusion into our system, we believe that your name, address and some personal information, including your social security number was acquired by the unauthorized party. Law enforcement and forensic experts are continuing to investigate the incident, but at this time we have no evidence that there has been any fraudulent use of your information.

We take this incident very seriously and are committed to assisting you in this unfortunate situation. To help ensure the security of your data, we are offering a free one-year membership to Experian's® ProtectMyID® Elite to help protect your identity. This product is a protection service that helps detect possible misuse of your information and facilitates identification and resolution of identity theft.

You may enroll in this free credit monitoring service any time before February 28, 2015 by visiting the ProtectMyID website at www.protectmyid.com/enroll. To activate the product, you will be required to enter an Activation Code. Your personal Activation Code is [ ]. If you are unable to enroll online, please call 1-866-579-2213.

We are taking measures to address this incident and to reduce the risk of additional harm.
