## Dear Attorney General:

We are following up on our letter dated August 19, 2021, in which we provided notice that T-Mobile had detected and shut down a security event that impacted the personal information of some New Hampshire residents. As we noted in the August 19th notice, T-Mobile's investigation of the event was still ongoing at that time. We are writing to inform you that our investigation is now complete, and in addition to providing substitute notice on August 19, 2021, T-Mobile sent individual notices to 116,079 New Hampshire residents between August 18 and October 24, 2021. In addition, we updated our notification website (<a href="https://www.t-mobile.com/brand/data-breach-2021">https://www.t-mobile.com/brand/data-breach-2021</a>) to reflect our findings.
