Re: Notification of Security Breach Affecting New Hampshire Residents

To Whom It May Concern:

On March 4, 2014, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the U.S. (VFW) received information that personal information of its members may have been compromised, including 371 individuals in New Hampshire. VFW determined that an unauthorized person gained access to its servers and, through that access, obtained personal information of its members, including name, address, and Social Security number in electronic form.

VFW removed the malicious code from its servers and terminated the hacker's access shortly after discovery. VFW has contracted with IT security professionals to analyze the breach. VFW will notify the individuals potentially affected, and has contracted with AllClear ID to provide identity theft services to the individuals whose information is at issue. Notification letters were mailed on April 4, 2014.
