## American Rescue Plan Act

The New Hampshire Department of Justice announces available federal funding for municipalities and state agencies to aid with activities related to relaxed COVID-19 restrictions. Funding is available beginning July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023. Funding is provided by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021, State Fiscal Recovery Funds (SFRF). The total amount of federal funding available is **\$2,000,000**.

All awards are subject to the availability of funds and to any modifications or additional requirements that may be imposed by law.

# **Eligibility:**

- State Agencies
- Units of Local Government

## Permissible Uses of Funds:

Funds awarded under this solicitation must be utilized to assist with activities related to relaxed COVID-19 restrictions. Eligible costs for reimbursement under this program consist of, but are not limited to, the following:

- Overtime
- Equipment
- Hiring
- Supplies
- Training
- Travel

**Prohibition of supplanting:** Funds may not be used to supplant state or local funds but must be used to increase the amounts of such funds that would, in the absence of federal funds, be made available.

#### **Award Information:**

Funding will be available until all federal funds are expended.

<u>Review Process</u>: All applications will be evaluated whether the information presented is reasonable, understandable, measurable, achievable, and allowable under the solicitation.

Applications may be disapproved in whole or in part if costs are not associated with activities directly related to relaxed COVID-19 restrictions. Awards are subject to required governmental approval, including the Attorney General and the Governor and Executive Council, and availability of federal funding.
