Request for Grant Applications

The New Hampshire Department of Justice announces available federal funding for New Hampshire Law Enforcement agencies to aid with one-time expenses. If awarded funds must be spent by September 30, 2023. The total amount of federal funding available is **\$500,000**.

All awards are subject to the availability of funds and to any modifications or additional requirements that may be imposed by law.

Eligibility:

• New Hampshire law enforcement agencies with 10 budgeted sworn police officers or less (combination of part time and full time).

Permissible Uses of Funds:

Funds awarded under this solicitation must be utilized to assist police departments with one-time costs. Eligible costs for reimbursement under this program consist of the following:

- Bullet proof vests (must be stab resistant)*
- Portable radios (must conform to New Hampshire Interobability Standards)**
- Body/Cruiser Cameras***
- Community Oriented Projects
- Training
- Other one-time capital expenses will be considered with a detailed description of the necessity and the limited resources to the law enforcement agency to acquire such equipment.

*Mandatory wear policy must be uploaded with application.

**Standards available upon request.

***Body/Cruiser camera police must be uploaded with application. Draft policy is allowable if not yet instituted.

Prohibition of supplanting: Funds may not be used to supplant state or local funds but must be used to increase the amounts of such funds that would, in the absence of federal funds, be made available.

Award Information:

<u>Applications will be accepted until November 18th, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.</u> Applicants can request no more than \$25,000.

<u>Review Process</u>: All applications will be evaluated and scored on whether the information presented is reasonable, understandable, measurable, achievable, and allowable under the solicitation. Additional consideration may be awarded to applications received from geographically limited areas to ensure that funding is distributed as evenly as possible throughout the state. Awards are subject to required governmental approval, including the Attorney General and the Governor and Executive Council, and availability of federal funding.
