The Consumer Protection and Antitrust Bureau is responsible for investigating and prosecuting unfair and deceptive business practices, complex financial fraud, financial exploitation of the elderly, illegal combinations, monopolies, and unfair methods of competition in various industries—include healthcare.

The Bureau has statewide civil and criminal prosecutorial authority. It also participates in multistate investigations and prosecutions with the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Trade Commission, and other state attorneys general. The Bureau is composed of a multidisciplinary team including attorneys, sworn law enforcement investigators, a financial analyst, paralegals and legal assistants.
