The New Hampshire Department of Justice seeks a full-time attorney to join the Consumer Protection and Antitrust Bureau.

The Consumer Protection and Antitrust Bureau investigates and prosecutes: consumer protection act violations and violations of related consumer protection statutes; antitrust violations; financial fraud; elder abuse and elder financial fraud. The unit has statewide prosecutorial authority and participates in multi-state investigations and litigation with other attorneys general offices. It prosecutes both criminal and civil cases. The unit is composed of a multi-disciplinary team including attorneys, sworn investigators, a financial analyst, paralegals, and legal assistants.

The ideal candidate will have experience in criminal litigation, protection of vulnerable persons, prosecution of fraud, and public service. Qualified applicants must have a Juris Doctor degree and membership in the New Hampshire Bar—or eligibility to waive in to the Bar by motion.
