



FULL-TIME LAW ENFORCEMENT INVESTIGATOR OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

The New Hampshire Department of Justice seeks a full-time law enforcement investigator to join its Criminal Justice Bureau. Investigators work alongside attorneys to examine the facts, circumstances, witnesses, and evidence relevant to various criminal allegations in order to ensure their just resolution and, where appropriate, prosecution of offenders. The Department has state-wide jurisdiction to investigate and prosecute crimes--including homicide, major drug crimes, Medicaid fraud, and public integrity offenses.

The successful candidate will be certified as a law enforcement officer in New Hampshire (or an out-of-state/federal officer eligible to obtain New Hampshire certification) who has demonstrated proficiency with current investigative techniques, witness interviewing, search warrant applications and execution, subpoenas, evidence collection, report writing, and previous experience testifying in court.

The position offers competitive salary commensurate with experience and excellent benefits--including health, dental, and life insurance.
