



ELDER ABUSE AND FINANCIAL EXPLOITATION PROSECUTOR OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

The New Hampshire Department of Justice seeks an attorney to join its Elder Abuse and Financial Exploitation Unit, which is responsible for investigating and prosecuting crimes committed against victims age 60 and older, and educating the public on related issues. Fully staffed, the Unit includes two attorneys, one investigator, a victim-witness advocate, paralegal, and program specialist.

Unit prosecutors appear in trial courts statewide to try significant, complex cases involving abuse, neglect, and financial exploitation. The successful candidate is admitted to the New Hampshire Bar (or waiver eligible) with a sincere interest in serving the public--in particular, the state's older adult population. A candidate with criminal litigation experience, experience reviewing estate, financial, and medical documents, and strong research and writing skills is preferred.

The position offers competitive salary commensurate with experience and excellent benefits--including health, dental, and life insurance.
