

MEDICAID FRAUD CONTROL UNIT ATTORNEY OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

The New Hampshire Department of Justice Medicaid Fraud Control Unit investigates and prosecutes Medicaid provider fraud as well as patient abuse or neglect in health care facilities.

The Unit has statewide civil and criminal jurisdiction. It is staffed by three attorneys, two law enforcement investigators, a financial analyst, paralegal, and legal assistant.

The successful candidate is a team player admitted to the New Hampshire Bar with litigation experience and sincere interest in public service. Research and communication skills, familiarity with the Medicaid program, and experience with financial crimes or fraud are preferred. Benefits include health, dental, and life insurance.
