

## **CRIMINAL JUSTICE BUREAU—MEDICAID FRAUD CONTROL UNIT ATTORNEY POSITION**

The New Hampshire Department of Justice seeks a full-time attorney to join the Criminal Justice Bureau's Medicaid Fraud Control Unit.

The Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU) investigates and prosecutes: Medicaid provider fraud; patient abuse or neglect in Medicaid-funded facilities; and abuse and neglect in "board and care" facilities, such as assisted living facilities. Abuse and neglect includes misappropriation of beneficiary funds. The unit has statewide prosecutorial authority and participates in multi-state global litigation. It prosecutes both criminal and civil cases. The unit is composed of a multi-disciplinary team including attorneys, sworn investigators, an auditor, paralegal, and legal assistant.

The ideal candidate will have experience or demonstrated interest in litigation, health care law, protection of vulnerable persons, prosecution of fraud, and public service. Qualified applicants must have a Juris Doctor degree and membership in the New Hampshire Bar—or eligibility to waive in to the Bar by motion. The salary is competitive and commensurate with experience; an excellent benefit package is included.
