Overview

New Hampshire senior living communities Silverstone Living of Nashua, comprising the Hunt Community, Huntington and At Home by Hunt, and Webster at Rye have initiated the process of affiliating. The two New Hampshire-based non-profit organizations share similar missions and cultures, and the idea of affiliating has been brewing for some time. The organizations signed a non-binding letter of intent in July 2022.

As part of the regulatory process, the organizations held a public listening session on Thursday, September 29, 2022, at Wentworth-by-the-Sea in Rye, NH to share their vision for affiliation, and to accept comments and questions from the public.

Montagne Powers advised and assisted Silverstone and Webster at Rye on communicating plans for the proposed affiliation and the public listening session to internal and external audiences, including their respective residents and families, staff, public officials and others, and the local media.

Montagne Powers also planned, produced and managed the listening session.




