Re: Security Breach Notification

Dear Attorney General MacDonald:

We are writing on behalf of our client, AG Source, Inc. ("AG Source"), to notify you of a security incident involving one (1) New Hampshire resident.

Around December 22, 2018, AG Source discovered a sophisticated cyber-attack on its systems that encrypted a number of AG Source's files, rendering them unreadable. Promptly after discovering this incident, AG Source involved law enforcement authorities, engaged this firm, retained third-party cybersecurity consultants, and started investigating and addressing the incident. AG Source's systems are now up and running again, and AG Source has access to the data that had been encrypted. AG Source is taking security measures that will strengthen its network and assist it in protecting against similar incidents in the future.

Although AG Source cannot be certain whether personal information of a New Hampshire resident was actually acquired by the cyber-attackers, out of an abundance of caution, AG Source will be providing notification to the potentially affected resident on or about February 6, 2019.
