To Whom It May Concern:

I write on behalf of Auris Health, Inc. to inform you about a recent incident in which personal information relating to two (2) New Hampshire residents may have been accessed by an unauthorized third party.

When Auris learned of the incident, Auris took action to halt the unauthorized activity, ensure the security of its system and remediate the issue.

Specifically, Auris discovered that, at least as of March 15, 2020, an unauthorized third party gained access to an Auris employee's email account. Upon learning of this event, Auris took steps to ensure that the unauthorized activity had ceased. Auris subsequently determined that the third party may have accessed or acquired full names and Social Security numbers belonging to New Hampshire residents.

In response to this incident, Auris is providing notice to all potentially impacted individuals and applicable regulators and is working to determine the full nature and scope of the event so that Auris can remediate any identified vulnerabilities and enhance the security controls of its systems to prevent this type of incident from recurring.

Auris will notify two New Hampshire residents of this incident on January 27, 2021, and will provide these individuals with an offer for two years of a complimentary three-bureau credit and identity fraud monitoring service provided by Equifax. An individual can enroll in the credit and identity fraud monitoring service by using the unique code provided to them in their notice letter to enroll on Equifax's website.
