*Re: Supplemental Incident Notification*

Dear Attorney General Formella:

We are writing on behalf of our client, CBIZ, Inc. to provide an update regarding the MOVEit security incident that we reported to your office on September 1, 2023.<sup>1</sup>

CBIZ has continued to work with its clients to identify individuals whose information was involved and identify addresses for those individuals. CBIZ has now mailed notification letters via United States Postal Service First-Class mail to a total of 3,238 New Hampshire residents in accordance with N.H. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 359-C:20.<sup>2</sup> The personal information varied by New Hampshire resident but included one or more of the following:

. CBIZ is offering complimentary credit monitoring, fraud consultation, and identity theft restoration services through Kroll to all New Hampshire residents whose [redacted] was involved in the incident.
