### Notice of Data Breach

Dear Attorney General MacDonald:

#### What Happened

CDI Electronics, Inc., has discovered that, during the first two weeks of July 2020, a group of cybercriminals gained unauthorized access to some of its systems and customer information. CDI Electronics first learned of the incident on July 17, 2020. This letter is being provided in compliance with N.H. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 359-C:20. Only one resident of New Hampshire was affected, to whom notice was provided on October 16, 2020.

#### What Information Was Involved

The compromised information included name, mailing address, home phone number, business phone number, email address, and social security number.

#### What We Are Doing

CDI Electronics values consumers' privacy and deeply regrets that this incident occurred. Upon learning of the incident, we immediately began working to mitigate risks and to improve security to protect information from further unauthorized access. We have implemented additional safeguards to improve data security on our email server. We are taking additional steps to protect data from theft or similar criminal activity in the future.

At this time, there is no evidence that any consumer's information has been misused.
