Re: Legal Notice of Information Security Incident


Dear Sirs or Madams:

I write on behalf of my client, Central Ohio Urology Group, Inc., to inform you of a data security incident that may have affected the personal information of approximately 16 New Hampshire residents. Central Ohio Urology Group is notifying these individuals and outlining some steps that potentially affected individuals may take to help protect themselves.

On August 2, 2016, an unauthorized individual posted files and documents to an online drive accessible on the Internet, which included personal information about patients, employees, and other individuals. The posted information appears to have been maintained by Central Ohio Urology Group on its internal file server. Central Ohio Urology Group believes that certain types of patient information may have been affected, including name, address, telephone number(s), email, birthdate, patient identification number, Social Security number, account information, driver's license/government identification number, medical and health insurance information and identifiers, employment information and diagnosis and treatment information.

Central Ohio Urology Group takes the privacy of personal information seriously, and deeply regrets that this incident occurred. Central Ohio Urology Group took steps to address this incident promptly after it was discovered, including contacting state and federal law enforcement, having the files and documents removed from the online drive, engaging a computer forensics firm to assist with an investigation into the incident, and carefully reviewing the posted files and documents to determine who may have been affected. To prevent this type of incident from recurring in the future, Central Ohio Urology Group also installed network monitoring software, implemented a new firewall, added access restrictions and began updating system protections.

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Individuals who may have been affected are being notified via written letter, which will begin mailing on or about September 22, 2016. A form copy of the notice letter being sent to potentially affected New Hampshire residents is included for your reference.
