Dear Attorney General Foster:

I am writing on behalf of my client, the Clinton Health Access Initiative (“CHAI”), to inform you of an information security incident that has come to our attention. We have identified 4 New Hampshire residents who may have been affected.¹

CHAI has determined that a member of its payroll department received a fraudulent email in late March, appearing and purporting to have come from a member of senior leadership within the organization, requesting copies of W-2s of CHAI employees. The request was responded to and the information was sent to an unauthorized outside email address that was masked as a CHAI email address. The information compromised consists of the information found on W-2 forms, including employee’s full names and Social Security numbers.

On April 1, 2016, CHAI mailed written notification to the New Hampshire residents who may have been affected, and, as a precaution, CHAI offered these residents two years of complimentary credit monitoring services and other precautionary information and measures that they can take to safeguard their identities. CHAI is also assisting such residents with the preparation of the forms that should be submitted to federal and state taxing authorities.
