Re: Incident Notification

Mr. Delaney:

On behalf of The Coca-Cola Company Family Federal Credit Union (“TCCCFFCU”), we are writing to inform you about a recent incident involving personal information owned by TCCCFFCU and relating to New Hampshire residents. Specifically, we recently were informed by our auditor, Credit Union Resources, Inc., that two laptops owned by Credit Union Resources, Inc. and containing TCCCFFCU information was stolen on December 21, 2011. Credit Union Resources, Inc. had been engaged by TCCCFFCU to perform an audit on our behalf.

We began investigating the incident as soon as we learned of it. Through our investigation, we have determined that the stolen laptops contained personal information regarding some of TCCCFFCU members, including member names, Social Security numbers and, in some instances, credit card numbers.

We have examined the measures we can take to help prevent incidents of this kind in the future. We have instructed Credit Union Resources, Inc. to take additional steps to protect the security of its laptops and our information.

In accordance with New Hampshire law, we will notify “13” New Hampshire residents on February 28, 2012.
