**Re: Security Event Notification**

Dear Sir or Madam:

We are providing notice on behalf of Eisai, Inc. ("Eisai"), pursuant to N.H. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 359-C:20, about an incident involving 1 New Hampshire resident.

On or about January 22, 2019, Eisai discovered that certain Eisai employees were the targets of "phishing" emails transmitted that same day. The "phishing" emails contained links that sought to compromise the recipients' Eisai email login credentials. Eisai immediately launched an investigation into this incident with the assistance of a leading cyber investigative firm. On February 21, 2019, Eisai determined that certain email accounts of Eisai employees were logged into on one occasion from a suspicious location.

On or about March 19, 2019, Eisai confirmed that certain limited types of unencrypted personal information were contained in an Eisai employee email account. The types of personal information at issue included: name and driver's license number.

Our investigation has not revealed any evidence that an unauthorized person actually accessed, viewed or otherwise compromised any personal information contained in the email accounts, and we have no information to indicate that the personal information was utilized for criminal activity.

We continue to diligently investigate and assess this incident. We have secured each email account and we continue to monitor for suspicious activity. We are continuing to enhance our identity, authentication and remote access controls, and to educate our workforce about cybersecurity issues.

We provided written notification to the affected New Hampshire resident on March 27, 2019.
