Re: Legal Notice of Information Security Incident

Dear Sirs or Madams:

I write on behalf of my client, First Home Mortgage Corp. ("First Home"), to inform you of a potential security incident that may have affected the personal information of approximately three New Hampshire residents. First Home is notifying affected individuals and is outlining some steps that potentially affected individuals may take to help protect themselves.

On July 10, 2016, a First Home employee had his vehicle broken into and his company laptop stolen. Although the computer was password protected and it is unlikely that the stored data was accessed, First Home believes that certain customer information, address, Social Security number, driver's license or identification number, and financial account number may have been stored on this device and could have potentially been affected as a result of the theft.

First Home takes the privacy of personal information very seriously, and deeply regrets that this incident occurred. First Home took steps to address and contain this incident promptly after it was discovered, including conducting a comprehensive review of our data security processes to help prevent this type of incident from recurring in the future. First Home has also contacted law enforcement and will continue to cooperate in their investigation of this incident.


