Re: Notification of Potential Breach of Security

To the Office of the Attorney General:

This notice is to alert you to a situation where personal information about some Freddie Mac Pension Plan participants who reside in the State of New Hampshire may have been accessed without authorization.

In April 2014, Freddie Mac learned from law enforcement that in April 2013, a person or persons had unauthorized access to certain Freddie Mac Pension Plan information. The Plan information included several Plan participants' names, addresses, Social Security Numbers, dates of birth, and plan status. Based on Freddie Mac's initial investigation at the time it first learned of the incident in April 2014, including information received from law enforcement, Freddie Mac had no reason to believe that any personal information of New Hampshire State residents had been accessed without authorization or misused. Recently, however, on August 5, 2016, law enforcement provided to Freddie Mac additional information that persons under criminal investigation in connection with the original incident appear to have accessed a few additional Plan participants' personal information.

At this time, we have not received any reports of improper access of any New Hampshire residents' personal information. Nonetheless, to be on the safe side, Freddie Mac sent notification letters out to all Pension Plan participants whether or not we were informed by law enforcement that their personal information was in fact improperly accessed.

Further information about what Freddie Mac has done and what we are recommending to the individuals in question can be found in the enclosed notification letter that Freddie Mac sent to three New Hampshire residents.
