RE: NOTICE OF POTENTIAL BREACH

Dear Attorney General Delaney:

I am an in-house attorney for The Hertz Corporation ("Hertz") and am writing to inform you about a recent incident in which personal information relating to New Hampshire residents may have been accessed by an unauthorized third party.

JP Morgan manages Order-to-Pay, a service which Hertz utilizes for accounts payable functions, such as purchase orders, invoicing and payments as well as for the payment of certain Hertz employee travel expenses. JP Morgan recently notified Hertz of unauthorized access to computer servers that housed certain Order-to-Pay information, which information included the names, addresses, bank account numbers and social security numbers of certain suppliers, consultants, employees and former employees of Hertz. JP Morgan has advised that upon identifying this unauthorized access, it conducted an investigation and concluded that, while there was no reason to believe any information was taken or misused, it may have been viewed. Upon learning of the incident, Hertz began an investigation to identify the individuals who were potentially impacted thereby. Based upon Hertz's investigation, we have determined that information regarding 8 New Hampshire residents was potentially involved and we anticipate mailing notices to these residents no later than August 3, 2012.

Hertz is taking this matter very seriously and has been working with JP Morgan to investigate this incident. JP Morgan has informed Hertz that the incident was reported to the United States Treasury Department's Office of the Comptroller of the Currency and that JP Morgan has already taken responsive actions including the use of additional security measures and the redesign of safeguards to strengthen defenses within its system. Furthermore, as a precaution, JP Morgan has offered personal credit monitoring to those individuals potentially affected by the incident.
