Dear Attorney General Delaney:

We write to advise you of an incident involving unauthorized access by a medical practice employee to electronic medical records and patient registration information, resulting in the potential compromise of the protected health information and personal information of two New Hampshire residents.

We are submitting this notice on behalf of Lawrence Melrose Medical Electronic Record, Inc. ("LMMER"), and on behalf of six medical practices whose patients resident in New Hampshire were affected by this incident (the "Practices"). The Practices are listed on Schedule I to this letter. LMMER and the Practices will also notify the Office of Civil Rights of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services in connection with the breach of protected health information as required by federal law.

In order to ensure that affected individuals may take steps to protect themselves from possible identity theft, LMMER will notify affected individuals of this incident on behalf of the Practices via first-class mail on or about March 14, 2013. The individual notification materials will describe the services LMMER and the Practices have made available to affected individuals whose personal information was compromised in connection with this incident through Kroll Advisory Solutions. LMMER and the Practices have engaged Kroll Advisory Solutions to provide one year of credit monitoring and identity theft consultation and restoration services to such individuals at no cost to them.


