**Re: Data Breach Notification Pursuant to N.H. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 359-C:20**

Dear Attorney General MacDonald,

We write on behalf of our client, Lourd Capital, LLC (“**LourdMurray**”), to inform the New Hampshire Office of the Attorney General of a potential compromise involving personal information of approximately one (1) New Hampshire resident pursuant to N.H. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 359-C:20.

On or about April 30, 2019, one of LourdMurray’s personnel became the victim of a malicious cyberattack from an unknown third party, which compromised a LourdMurray email account. This account held emails that contained personal information of some of LourdMurray’s current and former clients, current and former employees, and a limited number of other individuals. LourdMurray discovered the compromise on May 17, 2019, promptly took steps to secure the account, and began an investigation into the incident. LourdMurray does not believe, and has found no evidence that, the attack impacted other LourdMurray systems or accounts.

The personal information in the account related to the New Hampshire resident included some or all of the following: first and last name, email address, social security number, and/or other information that LourdMurray holds. As a result, that information may have been exposed to the attacker.


LourdMurray promptly acted to secure the compromised email account and worked diligently to investigate this matter, including engaging a forensics firm to perform forensic analyses on LourdMurray’s systems and accounts. LourdMurray reported the incident to, and is cooperating with, law enforcement, including the FBI and Dept. of Homeland Security.

LourdMurray anticipates mailing written notice to the affected New Hampshire resident on or about June 26, 2019. In addition, LourdMurray has engaged Experian to provide identity theft protection and credit monitoring services for two (2) years at no cost to the affected individuals.
