The undersigned represents MedEvolve in connection with the above-referenced matter. In accordance with RSA 359-C:20(b), please accept the following addendum to the July 10, 2018 breach notification from Medevolve.

The July 10, 2018 breach notification informed the Office of the Attorney General that MedEvolve was on the same day (July 10) notifying 84 New Hampshire residents about a data breach and providing those individuals with two (2) years of credit monitoring services through TransUnion. The purpose of this letter is to inform the Office of the Attorney General that after all of the notifications were sent through the National Change of Address ("NCOA") database, we understand that notifications were sent to 91 New Hampshire residents.
