Pursuant to requirements as specified under RSA 359-C:20, we are writing to notify your office that on February 13, 2007 one laptop computer was reported stolen/missing from the Merrill Lynch New York World Financial Center branch office. The laptop computer potentially contained information on approximately 5 individuals of whom are residents of the state of New Hampshire. This incident was reported to the New York Police Department, Precinct 1 on February 27, 2007, crime incident report number 1317. The information affected may have included: client name, company name, client or spouse Social Security number, client or spouse date of birth, telephone number, email address, mailing address, Merrill Lynch account number and in some cases a pin number (majority inactive) not associated with Merrill Lynch. A letter of notification will be mailed to all individuals involved in this incident on or about March 27, 2007.
