Re: **Notice of Cyber Security Incident**

Dear Attorney General Foster:

We write on behalf of QR Lending, a nationwide provider of residential mortgage lending services for community banks and credit unions, to notify you of a cyber security incident that may affect the security of the personal information of certain New Hampshire residents. This notice will be supplemented if any new significant facts arise subsequent to its submission. By providing this notice, QR Lending does not waive any rights or defenses regarding the applicability of New Hampshire law or personal jurisdiction.

Nature of the Cyber Security Incident

On June 29, 2016, QR Lending discovered that phishing emails were sent from two of its employees' email addresses. QR Lending immediately launched an investigation and retained third party forensic experts to assist in the investigation of the incident. QR Lending determined that the unauthorized individual or individuals who used the two employee's email accounts to send the phishing emails had access to the email messages in those accounts. For affected individuals that reside in New Hampshire, the personal information contained in the email accounts was some combination of name, Social Security number, driver's license number, address, date of birth, bank account number and Tax Identification Number.

Notice to New Hampshire Residents

On August 23, 2016, QR Lending began mailing notice letters to impacted members which includes six (6) New Hampshire residents. The notice was provided in substantially the same form as the letter attached here as *Exhibit A*.

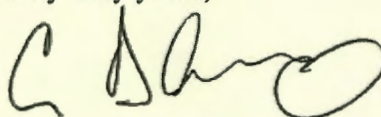
Other Steps Taken and To Be Taken

QR Lending is providing impacted members access to one (1) year of identity monitoring with Kroll at no cost. Additionally, QR Lending is providing impacted members with information on how to protect against identity theft and fraud, information on and encouragement to contact the Federal Trade Commission, the state attorney general, and law enforcement to report attempted or actual identity theft and fraud. QR Lending is providing written notice of this incident to other state regulators where required.
