Dear Mr. Foster:

RoundPoint Mortgage Servicing Corporation (RoundPoint) is contacting the Attorney General's Department of Justice regarding a data security incident that occurred on January 30, 2015. This incident involved sending New Hampshire resident's personal information to a nonaffiliated third party. The type of information sent included the resident's RoundPoint loan number, FHA case number, property address and loan terms along with the first and last name of the borrower. As a result, one (1) New Hampshire resident's personal information may have been potentially exposed to others. Please be assured that RoundPoint has taken remedial steps to ensure that this incident does not occur again. Please note that we are taking this incident seriously and are committed to assuring the security of New Hampshire resident's data.

Additionally, RoundPoint provided notice of this event to the affected New Jersey resident's on June 8, 2015. In that notice RoundPoint provided several disclosures to help reduce chances of identity theft for the borrower to review in the letters sent informing them of the incident.
