Notification to Consumer Protection

Dear Ms. Stratton:

Pursuant to RSA 359-C:20, Securitas Security Services USA ("Securitas USA") is hereby giving notice that on the night of April 26, 2007, six (6) laptop computers were stolen from Securitas USA'S Western Operation Center located at 4330 Park Terrace Drive, Westlake Village, California. It is believed that personal information pertaining to individuals' names, addresses, and social security numbers were available on at least one of these laptops. Law enforcement was notified immediately when the theft was discovered. Based upon their investigation, it is law enforcement's belief that the laptops were stolen for their intrinsic value and not for the informational value stored on their hard drives. To date, there is no confirmation that there has been any misuse of the personal information disclosed.


All affected persons were notified, in writing, by Securitas USA, of this breach on or about May 4, 2007. At this juncture, we estimate that letters were sent to 611 employees in New Hampshire.
