Attorney General MacDonald:


We represent the Securities Training Corporation (“STC”), an affiliate of the Colibri Group (“Colibri”). We are writing to notify you of a potential incident of unauthorized access to the personal information of three (3) New Hampshire residents.

On or about August 28, 2019, STC determined that the New Hampshire residents’ information, including their names and credit card numbers, may have been subject to unauthorized access. The information may have been accessed by an unauthorized third party between April 16th and June 14th, 2019 as a result of a potential compromise in an email account of an STC employee. The residents will receive notice of such incident via a written letter within seven (7) to ten (10) days.

When STC discovered the incident, it immediately took steps to prevent any further unauthorized disclosure of the personal information of the individual (as well as any other potentially impacted parties). STC has no evidence that the personal information of the New Hampshire residents has been used for fraudulent purposes. STC is offering the individuals twelve (12) months of free credit monitoring and identity theft assistance. STC takes this situation seriously, and is working to prevent this from happening again.
