Mr. Delaney:

On behalf of Sourcefire Inc., I am writing to inform you about a recent incident in which personal information maintained by Sourcefire relating to New Hampshire residents may have been accessed by an unauthorized party.

Specifically, we recently discovered that a company laptop was stolen on November 6, 2012. Upon learning of the incident, we immediately began conducting an investigation. Through our investigation, we have determined that the password-protected laptop contained files that included information relating to Sourcefire employees, including name and Social Security number. We have contacted law enforcement regarding this theft and are making every effort to recover the laptop.

At this time, we have no reason to believe that the target of this theft was the information stored on the laptop, as opposed to the device itself. Nonetheless, Sourcefire will notify our employees of this theft in writing on November 16, 2012. Specifically, we will notify two New Hampshire residents of the theft.
