TD Bank, N.A. is notifying your office of a privacy event impacting 2 New Hampshire residents. Our investigation identified two of our customers who are residents of New Hampshire and may have been affected by this incident.

We recently learned that one of our employees inappropriately obtained and used confidential customer information. The personal information which was exposed may have included name, address, date of birth, social security number, and account number. This is an isolated incident that is being addressed through an internal investigation by our corporate security team and we have engaged law enforcement.

We will be notifying our affected customers both in writing and by telephone. In addition, we have offered to transfer the funds in their affected account to a new account free of charge, and we will be offering two years of free credit monitoring. A copy of our customer notification letter is enclosed for your reference.
