**Re: Notification of Breach**

Dear Sir or Madam:


I am the Human Resources Manager of Virginia-based TMEIC Corporation and TMEIC International Corporation (collectively "TMEIC"). Please consider this TMEIC's notice that it has been the victim of a computer crime that involves the breach of its employees' personal information.

In particular, in March 2016 a TMEIC employee fell victim to a fraudulent email phishing scheme requesting W-2 wage information. The TMEIC employee sent the W-2 information of TMEIC's employees (approximately 300 individuals) to the fraudulent email. One of the impacted employees is a New Hampshire resident.

TMEIC immediately notified all employees of this breach. TMEIC has also notified the IRS Civil and Criminal Investigation Divisions, the FBI field office in Roanoke, and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Western District of Virginia. TMEIC remains in close contact with these agencies and continues to provide regular updates and information to federal law enforcement. TMEIC is also offering three years of identity theft protection at no charge to the impacted employees.
