Re: Notice of Data Event

Dear Sir/Madam:

Our office represents UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan. We are writing to provide you with notice of an event that may impact the security of personal information relating to 42 New Hampshire residents. By providing this notice, UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan does not waive any rights or defenses regarding the applicability of New Hampshire law, applicability of the New Hampshire data event notification statute, or personal jurisdiction.

Background

On or around July 21, 2016, UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan was the victim of a ransomware attack. UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan immediately began an investigation into the nature and the scope of this incident. A third-party data forensic firm was retained to assist in the investigation. After an extensive investigation, no evidence was found demonstrating that an unauthorized individual accessed or acquired information, however it was determined that an unauthorized user gained access to the UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan server on July 14, 2016, one week before the ransomware attack. While there is no evidence that information was accessed or acquired, we are unable to definitively rule out this possibility, and provided notice out of an abundance of caution. The information potentially affected by this incident include individuals' name, date of birth, Social Security Number, as well as bank account information for a subset of individuals.

Notice to New Hampshire Residents

This server contained information relating to 42 New Hampshire residents who provided their personal information directly to UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan. UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan is mailing written notice of this incident to these 42 New Hampshire residents on or about November 9, 2016, in substantially the same form as the letters attached hereto as *Exhibit A*.

Other Steps Taken and To Be Taken


UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan is offering those individuals impacted by this incident access to one free year of credit monitoring and identity restoration services with Kroll, and is providing these individuals with helpful information on how to protect against identity theft and fraud. In addition, UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan is offering the parents or guardians of affected minors and the families of deceased individuals impacted by this incident access to one free year of identity restoration and consultation services with Kroll, and is providing these individuals with helpful information on how to protect against identity theft and fraud.

UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan is taking steps to mitigate the risk that an event like happens again by, among other things, updating its security procedures and securing its network. In addition to providing notice of this incident to your office, UFCW Local 655 Food Employers Joint Pension Plan is providing notice of this incident to other regulators and consumer reporting agencies where required.
