## Student Loan Assistance for Prosecutors and Public Defenders

Estimated number of awards: up to 22

Estimated award amount: \$2,702.00

- Applications are due on or before 3:00 pm April 30, 2022.
- Applications may be accessed at <https://www.doj.nh.gov/grants-management/funding-availability.htm>
- Awards are made in the form of a one-time payment made directly to the lending institution holding the award recipient's eligible loan.

### Eligibility

- Eligible applications are prosecuting attorneys and public defenders earning less than \$100,000 per year.
- Only the following types of loans are eligible:
  1. Federal Family Education Loan Program
  2. William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan and Federal Perkins Loans
  3. Federal Consolidation loans and Federal Direct Consolidation loans

### Priority

- **Priority is given to applicants with the least ability to repay their student loans.**
- **Priority is given to 2018-2019 JRJ Award recipients.**
