#### **Eligibility**

- Eligible applications are prosecuting attorneys and public defenders earning less than \$100,000 per year.
- Only the following types of loans are eligible:
  - 1. Federal Family Education Loan Program
  - 2. William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan and Federal Perkins Loans
  - 3. Federal Consolidation loans and Federal Direct Consolidation loans

#### **Priority**

- Priority is given to applicants with the least ability to repay their student loans.
- Priority is given to 2018-2019 JRJ Award recipients.
