

SYNOPSIS OF THE ARMED ENCOUNTER BETWEEN JEFFREY CLOUGH-GARVIN AND LAW ENFORCEMENT

TIME: APPROXIMATELY 30 SECONDS

- 1. SERGEANT AUSTIN MAGUIRE AND POLICE OFFICER PAUL LEWIS ENTERED THE RESIDENCE
- 2. JUST INSIDE THE HOUSE, SERGEANT
 MAGUIRE ENCOUNTERED MR. CLOUGHGARVIN, WHO APPEARED TO BE HOLDING A
 GUN
- 3. SERGEANT MAGUIRE AND OFFICER LEWIS BOTH DIRECTED MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN TO DROP HIS GUN
- 4. SERGEANT MAGUIRE SAW MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN RAISE HIS GUN TOWARDS THE OFFICERS, AND SERGEANT MAGUIRE FIRED AT MR CLOUGH-GARVIN


- 5. MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN TOLD THE POLICE OFFICERS IN SUBSTANCE TO KILL HIM
- 6. MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN FIRED AT THE POLICE OFFICERS, HITTING OFFICER LEWIS TWICE IN THE ARM
- 7. SERGEANT MAGUIRE AND MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN BOTH FIRED MULTIPLE ADDITIONAL SHOTS
- 8. SERGEANT MAGUIRE AND OFFICER LEWIS WITHDREW FROM THE RESIDENCE

AUTOPSY OF JEFFREY CLOUGH-GARVIN

FINDINGS:

- 3 GUNSHOT WOUNDS (RIGHT LATERAL CHEST, LEFT POSTERIOR SHOULDER, LEFT UPPER BACK)
- NONE OF THE GUNSHOT WOUNDS WERE FATAL
- SELF-SUSTAINED SHOTGUN WOUND TO CHEST
- TOXICOLOGY RESULTS CONSISTENT WITH INGESTION OF A SUBSTANTIAL AMOUNT OF ALPRAZOLAM (XANAX), AS WELL AS ANTIDEPRESSANTS AND OXYCODONE

MANNER OF DEATH: SUICIDE

- .45-CALIBER SEMIAUTOMATIC PISTOL (TOP SLIDE LOCKED BACK)
- SIX .45-CALIBER SHELL CASINGS
- 12-GAUGE SHOTGUN (POINTED TOWARD MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN'S BODY, SPENT SLUG CASING IN CHAMBER)

- EIGHTEEN 9-MILLIMETER SHELL CASINGS
- BALLISTICS DAMAGE

NEW HAMPSHIRE STATUTE RSA 627:5, II(a)

Physical Force in Law Enforcement

A law enforcement officer is justified in using deadly force only when he reasonably believes such force is necessary:

(a) To defend himself or a third person from what he reasonably believes is the imminent use of deadly force. . . .

APPLICATION OF RSA 627:5, II(a)

CONSIDER ALL THE FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE INCIDENT

 WHAT IS "REASONABLE" IS DETERMINED BY AN OBJECTIVE STANDARD (VIEWING THE CONDUCT IN QUESTION FROM THE STANDPOINT OF A REASONABLE PERSON FACING THE SAME CIRCUMSTANCES)

CANNOT SECOND-GUESS CONDUCT WITH THE BENEFIT OF HINDSIGHT



 MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN'S WIFE REPORTED THAT HE MAY BE ARMED AND WOULD SHOOT POLICE OFFICERS

MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN HELD WHAT SERGEANT MAGUIRE BELIEVED TO BE A GUN

 MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN DID NOT COMPLY WITH MULTIPLE DIRECTIVES TO DROP HIS WEAPON



 MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN WAS IN FACT ARMED WITH LOADED WEAPONS THAT HE EVENTUALLY USED

 MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN HAD BEEN ACTING ERRATICALLY AND DANGEROUSLY BEFORE THE POLICE ENCOUNTERED HIM

MR. CLOUGH-GARVIN HAD THREATENED TO SHOOT HIMSELF AND OTHERS
