Incident Summary

On Wednesday May 20th, 2020 I was acting in full capacity as a Field Training Officer conducting routine patrol in Carroll County with my trainee, Probationary Trooper Margaret Ready. Tr. Ready and I were assigned to the cover shift, our duty hours from 0700 to 1530 hours. At approximately 1025 hours Tr. Ready attempted to stop a vehicle on Route 16 in the town of Albany after observing it had NH plates but no inspection sticker. The operator did not pull over immediately but turned into the parking lot for the Albany Town Hall, located at 1972 Route 16 in Albany. Upon further interaction with the operator, he refused to provide a license or registration to Tr. Ready. Tr. Ready proceeded to order him out of the vehicle several times but he refused to get out of his vehicle. He proceeded to lock the doors and roll up the window.

Tr. Ready and I both told the male subject he was under arrest and continued to order him to step outside the vehicle. It was clear the subject was not going to cooperate. I used my baton to break the driver's side window, to attempt to unlock the door. I observed the male's left hand, which was initially on his left leg, was moving down toward the area between the door and seat. I did not know if he had any weapons in the area and immediately reached through the partially broken window to secure his hand. I ordered the subject to stop moving and to keep his hands where I could see him. The male subject hit my hand and arm away several times while I was attempting to control him.

Tr. Ready was able to break the glass further, peel the window down, then reach in and unlock the door. The male continued to refuse to get out of the vehicle. We attempted to pull him out but were unable to move him. Tr. Ready removed her taser cartridge and drive-stunned him in the leg, which caused him to exit the vehicle.

Once outside, the male was ordered to the ground but continued to actively resist. When I attempted to gain control of his arms, he hit my hands away. Tr. Ready and I both grabbed his arms while he continued to try and pull away from us. We were able to trip him and push him to the ground. Tr. Ready and I both fell to the ground as well and continued to struggle with the subject, who continued to pull his arms away to prevent us from placing him in handcuffs. Tr. Ready and I were eventually able to place the subject in handcuffs.

The male subject was identified as

Due to the altercation, Tr. Ready and I sustained minor injuries, to include cuts and bruises. I sustained a cut on my left knee, and both knees will be bruised. I also sustained a small cut to my right index finger. I have not sought medical treatment for my injuries.

The subject was ultimately charged with Disobeying an Officer (265:4), Assault on an Officer (X2) (631:2-a), and Resisting Arrest (642:2).
