

The addition of a Rapiscan unit will also be an asset to the security of the facility by allowing staff to scan offenders for concealed weapons and contraband when they are brought into the building.

Superintendent Church and Jude Gates, the Maintenance Director, continually plan and budget for the up keep and preventative maintenance of the facility and grounds.

Mrs. Gates and her staff do a fine job of maintaining and making sure our facilities are up to code and safe for the inmates, clients, visitors and employees who work for the County.
