Dear Ms. Beaudoin

We have completed our search for and review of records regard to your request under New Hampshire RSA 91-A for:

All correspondences between the AG's office and the computer technician regarding the computer not resetting on Wednesday, May 12, 2021. I would like documentation as to who initiated the call to Anne Edwards, why she was asked to accompany an IT person to reboot a computer, how long was she there and for what purpose? Also all reports, files, correspondences pertaining to this event by both the AG's office and all parties responding to the call including a time line of events.

Please note that a state agency is only required to produce documents that currently exist and that are in its physical possession. There is no requirement under RSA 91-A to create documents that do not currently exist. After review of the Attorney General's Office's documents, we have determined that the Attorney General's Office does not have any records that are responsive to your request. Related documents that exist, such as the State Police recordings and text, and the email forwarded by me explaining what occurred on May 12, 2021, were already produced to you and are the only documents that are responsive to your request.
